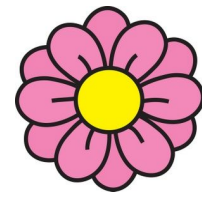

- The inside of a cucumber can be 20 degrees colder than the outside



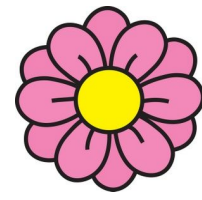

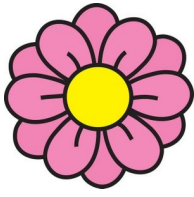

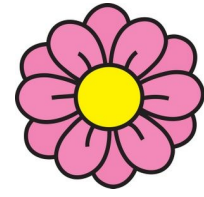
